ID #	Issue
29302	Remote (issue on Windows 7 64-bit in combination with Cubase/Nuendo 32-bit): when turning the hardware encoder very slowly (clockwise) for fine adjustments, the parameter is updated constantly.
29272	Remote: when exporting audio, the Control Room continues to respond to Avid MC Pro & MC Control remote control surface commands.

Known issues and solutions

The following table describes known issues you may encounter using Cubase / Nuendo with the EuCon adapter as well as possible workarounds.

ID #	Issue	Solution
	EuCon hardware disconnects from Cubase/Nuendo after a short period of time (about 10 seconds).	If a modal dialog is staying open for too long, the EuCon software may disconnect (a modal dialog is a window, which must be closed before Cubase or Nuendo can be operated further). Therefore please make sure to close the modal dialog in a short time frame. Additionally disable the following preference: VST>Plug-ins: "Warn before removing modified effects".
	EuCon hardware disconnects from Cubase/Nuendo after about 10 seconds.	Deactivate any network background services such as firewalls, virus scanner software, Norton Internet Security, etc.
	EuCon hardware connection to Cubase/Nuendo is temporarily interrupted.	Adjust the Windows User Account Control settings (UAC) to "Never notify" (see screenshot below).
