What is TOOLS for CI2?

TOOLS for CI2 is necessary when connecting the device to a computer. When you install the TOOLS for CI2, “Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver” and “Steinberg CI2 Extension” will be installed. The “Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver” allows communication between the device and a computer. Using Steinberg CI2 Extension, you can link the CI2/CI2+ with a Cubase version which supports the Link functions between both of them.

What is TOOLS for UR28M?

TOOLS for UR28M is necessary when connecting the device to a computer. When you install the TOOLS for UR28M, “Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver” and “Steinberg UR28M Applications” will be installed. The “Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver” allows communication between the device and a computer. The “Steinberg UR28M Applications” allows setting the parameters of the device from a computer or using the Link function between the device and Cubase series. The “Steinberg UR28M Applications” consist of four software components; “dspMixFx UR28M,” “UR28M Extension,” “Sweet Spot Morphing Channel Strip,” and “REV-X.”

What is TOOLS for UR824?

TOOLS for UR824 is necessary when connecting the device to a computer. When you install the TOOLS for UR824, “Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver” and “Steinberg UR824 Applications” will be installed. The “Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver” allows communication between the device and a computer. The “Steinberg UR824 Applications” allows setting the parameters of the device from a computer or using the Link function between the device and Cubase series. The “Steinberg UR824 Applications” consist of four software components; “dspMixFx UR824,” “UR824 Extension,” “Sweet Spot Morphing Channel Strip,” and “REV-X.”

Software Installation

Follow the steps below to install the software.

- If the same software components have already been installed in your computer, you can use the same procedure as described in the Installation instructions here to update the software.

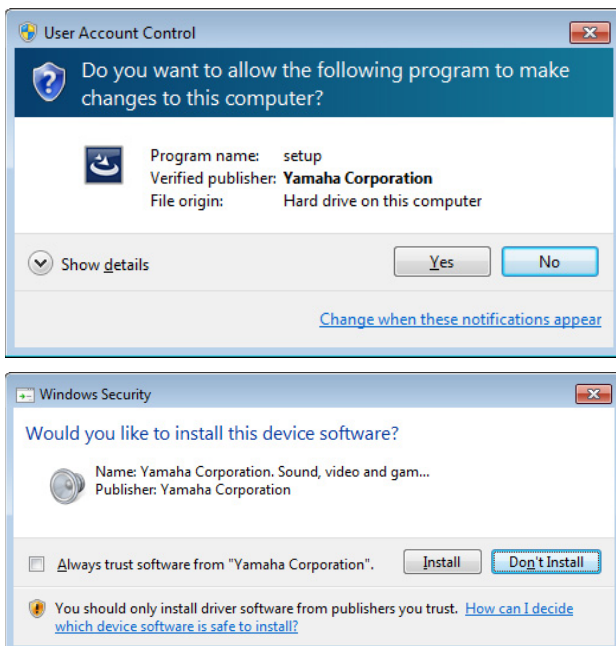
Preparation

If the following warning messages appear during the installation, click [Continue Anyway], [Yes], or [Install].

Installation

- 1 Turn off the computer.**
- 2 Disconnect all USB devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer.**
- 3 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.**
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 4 Double-click “setup.exe” in the compressed file (you have downloaded).**
- 5 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.**

Install the following software in order.

TOOLS for CI2

- Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Steinberg CI2 Extension

TOOLS for UR28M

- Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Steinberg UR28M Applications

TOOLS for UR824

- Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Steinberg UR824 Applications

- 6 When installation has been completed, click [Finish].**

If a window requiring you to restart your computer appears, follow the on-screen instructions and restart the computer.

Device Connection

- 7** Connect the device directly to the computer by using the included USB cable.
Make sure not to connect it to a USB hub.
- 8** Turn on the device (UR28M, UR824 Only).

Windows XP:
The “Found New Hardware Wizard” window appears. Go on to step 9.

Windows Vista / Windows 7 / Windows 8:
Go on to step 12.
- 9** If the “Can Windows connect to Windows Update to search for software?” message appears in the middle of the window, select “No, not this time” then click [Next].
- 10** Confirm that the “Install the software automatically” has been selected then click [Next].
- 11** When the installation has been completed, click [Finish].

Confirmation of Installation

- 12** Open the “Device Manager” window as follows.

Windows XP:
[Control Panel] → ([Performance and Maintenance]) → [System] → [Hardware] tab → [Device Manager]

Windows Vista / Windows 7 / Windows 8:
[Control Panel] → ([Hardware and Sound]) → [Device Manager]
- 13** Click on the [+] mark or [>] mark next to “Sound, video and game controllers.”
- 14** Confirm that the device name is listed.

Installation of the software is now complete.

Mac

Installation

- 1** Turn off the computer.
- 2** Disconnect all USB devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer.
- 3** Start the computer and log in to the Administrator account.
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 4** Double-click the following files (contained in the compressed file you have downloaded).

“TOOLS for CI2 V***.pkg”

TOOLS for UR28M
“TOOLS for UR28M V***.pkg”

TOOLS for UR824
“TOOLS for UR824 V***.pkg”

*** represents the version number.
- 5** Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.
- 6** When installation has been completed, click [Restart] to restart the computer.

Device Connection

- 7** Connect the device directly to the computer by using a USB cable.
Make sure not to connect it to a USB hub.
- 8** Turn on the device (UR28M, UR824 Only).

Confirmation of Installation

- 9** Open the “Audio MIDI Setup” window as follows.
[Macintosh HD] → [Applications] → [Utilities] → [Audio MIDI Setup]
- 10** Confirm that the device name is listed in the following.

- Steinberg CI2 Extension

TOOLS for UR28M

- Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Steinberg UR28M Applications
- (Mac only) VST Plug-Ins

TOOLS for UR824

- Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Steinberg UR824 Applications
- (Mac only) VST Plug-Ins

Windows

1 Disconnect all other USB devices except mouse and keyboard from the computer.

2 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.

Exit any open applications and close all open windows.

3 Open the window for the uninstall operation as follows.

Windows XP:

Select [Control Panel] → [Add or Remove Programs] to display the Add or Remove Programs panel. Click “Change or Remove Programs” located in the upper left.

Windows Vista / Windows 7 / Windows 8:

Select [Control Panel] → [Uninstall a program] to call up the “Uninstall or change a program” panel.

4 Select the software to be uninstalled from the list.

5 Uninstall them as follows.

Windows XP:

Click [Change/Remove] / [Remove].

Follow the on-screen instructions to remove the software.

Windows Vista / Windows 7 / Windows 8:

Click the [Uninstall] / [Uninstall/Change].

If the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue] or [Yes].

Follow the on-screen instructions to remove the software.

Uninstallation of the software is now complete.

Mac

- 1** Disconnect all USB devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer.
- 2** Start the computer and log in to the Administrator account.
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 3** After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the following files.

- Uninstall Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Uninstall Steinberg CI2 Extension

TOOLS for UR28M

- Uninstall Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Uninstall Steinberg UR28M Applications
- Uninstall VST Plug-Ins

TOOLS for UR824

- Uninstall Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver
- Uninstall Steinberg UR824 Applications
- Uninstall VST Plug-Ins

- 4** Click [Run] when the “Welcome to the *** uninstaller.” window appears.
*** represents the software name.
After that, follow the on-screen instructions to uninstall the software.
- 5** Click [Restart] or [Close], after the “Uninstallation completed.” window appears to indicate the operation is finished.
- 6** (Yamaha Steinberg USB Driver Only)
When the message prompting you to restart your computer appears, click [Restart].

Uninstallation of the software is now complete.
