What is TOOLS for CMC?

TOOLS for CMC is necessary when connecting the device to a computer, and consists of “Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver” and “Steinberg CMC Applications.”

“Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver” allows communication between the device and a computer.

“Steinberg CMC Applications” consists of “Steinberg CMC Extension,” “Steinberg CMC-PD Editor” and “Steinberg CMC-QC Editor.” “Steinberg CMC Extension” allows you to link the device with Cubase. “Steinberg CMC-PD Editor”/ “Steinberg CMC-QC Editor” allows you to edit various settings of CMC-PD/ CMC-QC on a connected computer.

TOOLS for CMC Installation

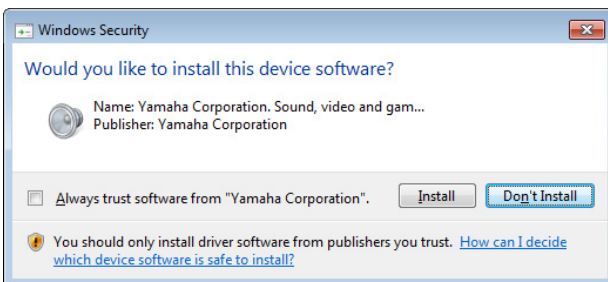
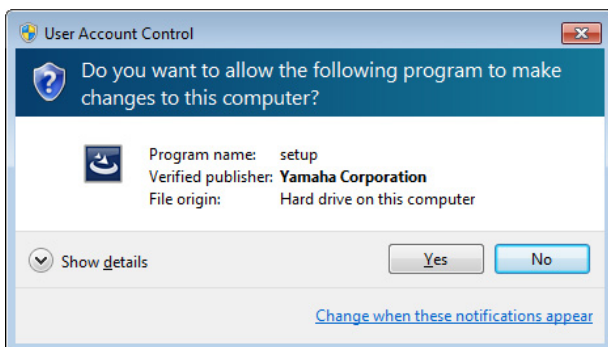
NOTE

Windows

Before installing

If the following warning messages appear during the installation, click [Yes] or [Install].



Installation

- 1 Disconnect all USB devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer.**
- 2 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.**
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 3 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the file “setup.exe.”**
- 4 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.**
Install the following software in the order below.
 - Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver
 - Steinberg CMC Applications
- 5 When installation has been completed, click [Finish].**
If a window requiring you to restart your computer appears, follow the on-screen instructions and restart the computer.
- 6 Connect the device directly to the computer by using the included USB cable.**

Installation of the TOOLS for CMC is now complete.

Mac

Installation

- 1 Disconnect all USB devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer.**
- 2 Start the computer and log in to the Administrator account.**
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 3 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the file “TOOLS for CMC V***.pkg.”**
*** represents the version number.
- 4 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.**
- 5 When installation has been completed, click [Close] .**
- 6 Connect the device directly to the computer by using the included USB cable.**

Installation of the TOOLS for CMC is now complete.

Uninstalling the TOOLS for CMC

You must remove the following two software components installed from the TOOLS for CMC.

- Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver
- Steinberg CMC Applications

Follow the steps below to uninstall the software.

Windows

- 1 Disconnect all USB devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer.**
- 2 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.**
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 3 Open the window for the uninstall operation as follows.**
Select [Control Panel] → [Uninstall a program] to call up the “Uninstall or change a program” panel.
- 4 Select one of the software components from the list.**
- 5 Uninstall them as follows.**
Click [Uninstall] or [Uninstall/Change]. Follow the onscreen instructions to remove the software.

Uninstallation of the TOOLS for CMC is now complete.

Mac

- 1 Disconnect all USB devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer.**
- 2 Start the computer and log in to the Administrator account.**
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 3 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the following software.**
To remove Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver:
Uninstall Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver
To remove Steinberg CMC Applications:
Uninstall Steinberg CMC Applications
- 4 Click [Run] when the “Welcome to the Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver uninstaller” or “Welcome to the Steinberg CMC Applications uninstaller” window appears.**
After that, follow the on-screen instructions to uninstall the software.
- 5 After completing the uninstallation, an “Uninstallation completed” window appears. Click [Close].**

Uninstallation of the TOOLS for CMC is now complete.
