About sonote beat re:edit

sonote beat re:edit is a VSTi plug-in software and employs the special proprietary “sonote technology,” which Yamaha has developed. The software is compatible with Steinberg’s VST 3 technology and can be used as a VST3 plug-in with Cubase 7 / Cubase Artist 7. This new sonote technology automatically extracts and categorizes characteristic segments of sound from audio data. These segments of sound are individually called “sonote.” Each sonote has multiple characteristics in addition to the waveform data, and they are automatically categorized according to their characteristic patterns.

Minimum System Requirements

Requires a system equivalent to Cubase series Version 7 or later (Cubase 7/Cubase Artist 7). Future upgrades of application and system software and any changes in specifications are announced separately on the following website.

For Windows Users

Installing the software

Follow the instructions below to install sonote beat re:edit.

NOTE When the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue] or [Yes].

NOTE Make sure to install this software under the “Administrator” account.

- 1 Double-click the “sonote beat re-edit.exe” file extracted from the compressed file downloaded from the web site.**
- 2 Click [Next] from the window “Install Yamaha sonote beat re:edit to the computer” called up in step 1.**

NOTE If an older version of sonote beat re:edit has been installed in your computer, the software should be updated. (The procedure is the same as that of installing it from scratch.)
- 3 Install the software by following the on-screen instructions.**
- 4 Click [Finish] when “Completed” appears.**

Uninstalling the software

Follow the instructions below to uninstall sonote beat re:edit.

NOTE In addition to the instructions below, you can uninstall the software by double-clicking “sonote beat re-edit.exe,” selecting [Uninstall] then clicking [Next] on the customize window.

- 1 Select [Start] → ([Settings] →) [Control Panel] → [Programs and Features] to call up the “Uninstall or change a program” window.**
- 2 Select “Yamaha sonote beat re:edit Plug-in **bit” from the list.**

** Indicates the number of bits of the version selected during installation.
- 3 Click [Uninstall]/[Uninstall/Change].**

If the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue].
- 4 Follow the on-screen instructions to remove the software.**

For Mac Users

Installing the software

Follow the instructions below to install sonote beat re:edit.

NOTE Make sure to install this software under the "Administrator" account.

- 1 Double-click the "sonote beat re-edit.pkg" file extracted from the compressed file downloaded from the web site.**
- 2 Click [Continue] on the "Welcome to the sonote beat re:edit Installer" window called up in step 1.**

NOTE Click [Continue] if the message "This package contains a program that determines if the software can be installed. Are you sure you want to continue?" appears.
- 3 Install the software by following the on-screen instructions.**
- 4 Click [Close] when a message indicating that installation has been completed appears.**

Uninstalling the software

An uninstaller is not included in the Mac version. Please manually delete the following folders and files in the Macintosh HD.

"/Users/xxx/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/beat_reedit_Plug-in.vst3"

"/Users/xxx/Library/Application Support/Yamaha/sonote beat re-edit"

"/Users/xxx/Library/Audio/Presets/Yamaha Corporation/sonote beat re/edit"
