

### WaveLab 7.2, WaveLab Elements 7.2, WaveLab LE 7.2 – fixed issues

Issue	Version	Area
<b>Changing marker type</b> When changing the marker type from the Audio File's marker tool window, a crash could happen.	All Versions	Audio Editing
<b>Editing marker time in the marker window</b> If the marker was placed beyond the end of the last clip, it was not always possible to change its time.	All Versions	Audio Montage
<b>Audio Input plug-in</b> Only temporary files could be rendered and only in 24 bit.	All Versions	Plugin
<b>Crash could randomly happen after VST plug-in processing</b>	All Versions	Plugin
<b>Shortcuts within the Record dialog</b> Changing a shortcut did not happen until restarting WaveLab. The default shortcut for "record", has been changed to '*' (previous setting: Ctrl/Cmd + Enter).	All Versions	Recording
<b>OSQ file format</b> Encoders/Decoders were broken.	All Versions	Rendering & importing
<b>Render dialog, name history</b> Instead of the "File name" field, designations such as "Set as clip names" could appear in the history sub-menu.	All Versions	Rendering & importing
<b>Document tab color</b> When a document has been created and was not saved, the tab name changed to purple color, for better visibility. But after saving the document, its tab color was not reset to the standard color (black).	All Versions	User Interface

Issue	Version	Area
<b>Popup tips</b> When using a second monitor, the popup tips could be displayed on the wrong monitor (eg. Audio Montage envelope point info).	All Versions	User Interface
<b>Tool window shortcuts</b> A shortcut assigned to show/hide a Tool window within a workspace (eg. audio file) was unavailable in another workspace (eg. Montage workspace).	All Versions	User Interface
<b>Update of the audio streaming engine on the Mac.</b> The WaveLab 7.2 family comes with an update of the audio streaming engine on the Mac, in order to achieve improved performance on Mac OSX Lion.	Mac only	General feature
<b>Possible crash when using effects within the audio montage</b> Sometimes, WaveLab crashed randomly.	WaveLab 7.2 & WaveLab Elements 7.2 only	Audio Montage
<b>CD-Text in japanese</b> CD-Text in japanese was not properly encoded.	WaveLab 7.2 & WaveLab Elements 7.2 only	CD burning
<b>CD-Text with long fields</b> CDs with many tracks and with long CD-Text couldn't be burned.	WaveLab 7.2 & WaveLab Elements 7.2 only	CD burning
<b>Possible truncation of clips</b> Clips using plug-ins with long internal latency might have been truncated when burning a CD without rendering a temporary file or when generating a DDP file set while the montage had the "Audio in pause" mode disabled	WaveLab 7.2 & WaveLab Elements 7.2 only	CD burning
<b>Global Analysis / Loudness</b> The loudness value displayed at the bottom, left to the dialog, did not take into account the AES-17 setting of the global preferences (typically, the value was displayed with an offset of 3 dB).	WaveLab 7.2 only	Analysis
<b>Dual-mono files and companion file</b> It was not possible to save/restore a companion file (Master Section preset) for dual mono files.	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Editing

<p><b>Saving dual mono files</b>  Several issues could happen concerning dual-mono files:  When saving a dual-mono file as a stereo file (not dual mono anymore), the file was properly saved, but the file remaining opened in memory contained several channel assignement errors. In case the file format was set to "Channels match input stream", the resulting audio format was "Stereo" and not "Dual-mono". When overwriting a dual-mono file, the warning message regarding the overwriting of existing files was not displayed. When a dual-mono file was saved via the "save as" dialog, the resulting right channel file was left open invisibly in WaveLab, which prevented re-saving of the file under the same name.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Editing
<p><b>Spectrum Editing</b>  After stopping the playback, the window layout could change randomly.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Editing
<p><b>Huge W64 files</b>  W64 files with a length of several hour longs could not be read occasionally.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Editing
<p><b>Audio Montage / File Tool window</b>  The displayed file size was wrong.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Montage
<p><b>Audio Range dialog in Montage</b>  This tool could cause a crash.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Montage
<p><b>Batch Clip Renaming</b>  The clips are now sorted by start time before being renamed.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Montage
<p><b>CD Report</b>  In case the option "Generating specific file" was not activated, the report file could be created in a wrong way.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Montage
<p><b>Marker attachment</b>  When changing the attachment mode of a marker, the associated icon symbol was not updated immediatly in the marker list. The active mode is now pre-selected in the marker 'Functions' menu and the associated button is pushed.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Montage
<p><b>Montage template</b>  When saving a template, the option "Save markers" had no effect.</p>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Audio Montage

Issue	Version	Area
<b>CD Track pre-gap</b> The pre-gap values were not always correct. Solution: if a pre-gap or post-gap is longer than 10 seconds, the symbol "+?" is now displayed.	WaveLab 7.2 only	CD burning
<b>Importing Japanese CD-Text</b> When importing a DDP file containing Japanese CD-Text the text was not properly decoded.	WaveLab 7.2 only	CD burning
<b>Playback of huge audio files (several hours) did not work properly.</b>	WaveLab 7.2 only	Playback
