What is new in this release

- Files used for diagnostics can now be gathered together and compressed into a ZIP file when required. A new menu item in the account menu called “Create Diagnostics Report” will trigger the action. The action will also be available in a selection of error message dialogs to assist with the support process.

What is improved in this release

- Improved reliability when communicating with eLicenser for older licenses
- When requesting a licence for an application that can support several variants (e.g. Pro vs Elements), SAM will now prefer to activate a more capable variant if it is already aware that a licence exists for it, even if a less capable licence has previously been used.

What is new in this release

- When you activate your product, Steinberg Activation Manager will now associate the name of your computer with the activated license. The computer name is shown in the [products section of the Steinberg ID account management website](#) so you can easily see which computers have been activated.
- A new settings dialog allows you to override the default computer name.
- By default, when you launch a Steinberg Licensing product and have a license available, Steinberg Activation Manager will automatically activate that license. You may wish to prevent this behaviour in certain situations. You can now enable and disable this feature by toggling the “Auto-activation” switch in the settings dialog.
- You can now access the offline activation feature via the command line. Documentation on this feature can be found by invoking the Steinberg License Engine binary with the “-h” or “--help” argument

- Steinberg Activation Manager starts up faster
- Performance and reliability has improved
- Your Steinberg ID is more prominent in the UI to help our support team assist you more efficiently

- You can now activate a computer that is offline by using Steinberg Activation Manager to generate a license request file on the offline computer, taking the file to an online computer and using Steinberg Activation Manager to generate a license activation file which can be taken back to the offline computer and used to complete the activation of those products. The full process is described within Steinberg Activation Manager

What is improved in this release

- You will receive a system notification on Windows if the sign-in process has completed and the main window of Steinberg Activation Manager is not in focus

- You will need to be connected to the Internet connection to activate/deactivate

- You can now check your eligibility for grace period licenses and, if eligible, launch the grace period process

- The login mechanism reliability has been improved. **Note: as a result, you will be asked to sign in again**
- A bug which may result in your activation limit being incorrectly reached has been fixed
- Handling of situations when you are not connected to the Internet has been improved
- Performance and stability has improved

What is new in this release

- Beta and Not-for-resale (NFR) licenses are displayed as such
- On activation, time-limited licenses will display their “valid until” date
- You will be notified as you approach the end of your time-limited license

What is improved in this release

- If you have multiple licenses for the same product they are shown – and can be activated/deactivated – separately
- Handling of situations when you are not connected to the Internet have been improved
- Performance and stability has improved

What has been fixed in this release

- You will see fewer repeated notifications when no license is available
- If you have non-English characters in your Windows username you will no longer need to sign in each time you open Steinberg Activation Manager
- If you use a third-party host with Steinberg products protected by eLicenser, the licensing checking process no longer hangs
- Performance and stability has been improved
