Software Installation

Follow the steps below to install the software.

For information on the OS requirements for the software, refer to the Release Notes of the corresponding software.

Mac

Installation

- 1** Turn off the computer.
- 2** Disconnect all unnecessary devices from the computer.
- 3** Start the computer and log in to the Administrator account.
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 4** Double-click the following files (contained in the compressed file you have downloaded).

TOOLS for AXR4T

“TOOLS for AXR4T V***.pkg”

*** represents the version number.

- 5** Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.

NOTE

- If the dialog window about system extensions appears, open the “Security & Privacy” on “System Preferences” and allow the computer to load system software from developer “Yamaha Corporation”.

- 6** When installation has been completed, click [Restart] to restart the computer.

Device Connection

- 7** Turn off the computer.
- 8** Connect the AXR4 device to the computer with a certified Thunderbolt 2 cable.
Connect the AXR4 device to the computer directly without connecting other devices or using a daisy chain connection.
- 9** Turn on the device.

Confirmation of Installation

- 10** Start the computer and log in to the Administrator account.
- 11** Open the “Audio MIDI Setup” window as follows.
[Applications] → [Utilities] → [Audio MIDI Setup]
- 12** Confirm that the device name is listed in the left column.

Installation of the software is now complete.

Uninstalling the Software

To uninstall the software, you must remove the software one by one.

Mac

- 1 Disconnect all unnecessary devices from the computer.**
- 2 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.**

Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 3 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the following files.**
 - Uninstall Steinberg AXR Applications.app
 - Uninstall Equalizer 601.app
 - Uninstall Compressor 276.app
 - Uninstall Sweet Spot Morphing Channel Strip.app
 - Uninstall REV-X.app
 - Uninstall Yamaha Steinberg Thunderbolt Driver.app

- 4 Click [Run] when the “Welcome to the *** uninstaller” window appears.**

*** represents the software name.
After that, follow the on-screen instructions to uninstall the software.

- 5 After the “Uninstallation completed” window appears, indicating the operation is finished, click [Restart] or [Close].**

NOTE 

- When you run the “Uninstall Yamaha Steinberg Thunderbolt Driver.app,” [Restart] is displayed. When you run another software, [Close] is displayed.
- When you click [Restart], and a message prompting you to restart your computer appears, click [Restart].

Uninstallation of the software is now complete.
