

Steinberg TOOLS for AXR4T Installation Guide

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What is TOOLS Software

TOOLS for AXR4T is necessary when connecting the device to a computer. TOOLS for AXR4T includes the following software.

Software Installation

Follow the steps below to install the software.

NOTE

- Use TOOLS for AXR4T compatible with the AXR4T device firmware version.
The compatibility of the TOOLS for AXR4T version and the AXR4T device firmware version can be confirmed on the following website:
<https://www.steinberg.net/>
- You are only permitted to use this software pursuant to the terms and conditions of the “License Agreement” shown during the installation.
- If the same software components have already been installed in your computer, you can use the same procedure as described in the Installation instructions here to update the software.
- For information on the OS requirements for the software, refer to the Release Notes of the particular software.
- Alert messages such as User Account Control and Windows Security may appear during the installation. When such messages appear, click [Yes] or [Install] after confirming that the publisher is “Yamaha Corporation.”

When using AXR4T for Windows, in addition to the TOOLS for AXR4T, install the software to enable the Thunderbolt function in Windows. The required software has two options depending on your computer: 1) Thunderbolt software, or 2) Thunderbolt Control Center and DCH-compliant Thunderbolt bus drivers.

For the software installation, check your computer or the motherboard manufacturer's product information site.

Installation

- 1 Turn off the computer.**
- 2 Disconnect all unnecessary devices from the computer.**
- 3 Start the computer and log on/log in to the Administrator account.**
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 4 Double-click “Install_TOOLS_for_AXR4T.exe” (Windows) or “TOOLS for AXR4T V***.pkg” (Mac) (contained in the compressed file you have downloaded).**
*** represents the version number.
- 5 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.**
On Mac, if a dialog window about system extensions appears, open the “Privacy & Security” item in System Settings. Set the “Privacy & Security” settings in step 7.
- 6 When installation has been completed, click [Finish] or [Restart] to restart the computer.**

The following procedure is for Mac only.

- 7 Open “Privacy & Security” in the System Settings and allow the computer to load the application “Yamaha Steinberg Thunderbolt Control Panel.”**

Device Connection

- 8 Turn off the computer.**
- 9 Connect the AXR4T device to the computer with a certified Thunderbolt 2 cable and the Thunderbolt 3 to Thunderbolt 2 adapter.**
At AXR4T, connect the device to the computer directly without connecting other devices or using a daisy chain connection.
The Thunderbolt 3 to Thunderbolt 2 adapter is not required when you use a Mac equips with a Thunderbolt 2 connector.
- 10 Turn on the device.**
- 11 Start the computer and log on/log in to the Administrator account.**

NOTE

- On Windows, if the “Approve Thunderbolt™ Devices” window appears, select “Always Connect” then click [OK].

The following steps are required for Windows only.

- 12 If the “Can Windows connect to Windows Update to search for software?” message appears in the middle of the window, select “No, not this time” then click [Next].**
- 13 Confirm that the “Install the software automatically” has been selected then click [Next].**
- 14 When the installation has been completed, click [Finish].**

Confirmation of Installation

Windows

15 Open the “Device Manager” window as follows.

Right click the [start] button → [Device Manager]



- You can also open the “Device Manager” window by selecting [Control Panel] → ([Hardware and Sound]) → [Device Manager].

16 Click on the [+] mark or [>] mark next to “Sound, video and game controllers.”

17 Confirm that the device name is listed.

Mac

12 Open the “Audio MIDI Setup” window as follows.

[Applications] → [Utilities] → [Audio MIDI Setup]

13 Confirm that the device name is listed in the left column.

Installation of the software is now complete.

Uninstalling the Software

To uninstall the software, you must remove the software one by one.

Windows

1 Disconnect all unnecessary devices from the computer.

2 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.

Exit any open applications and close all open windows.

3 Open the window for the uninstall operation as follows.

[Settings] → [Apps] (Apps & features)



- You can also open the window by selecting [Control Panel] → [Uninstall a program] to call up the “Uninstall or change a program” panel.

4 Select a software to be uninstalled from the list.

- Yamaha Steinberg Thunderbolt Driver
- Steinberg AXR Applications
- Advanced FX Suite

* Depending on the version of Windows, click [:] on the right side of Advanced FX Suite to open the menu.

5 Uninstall the software as follows.

Click the [Uninstall].

If the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue] or [Yes].

Follow the on-screen instructions to remove the software.

Uninstallation of the software is now complete.

Mac

1 Disconnect all unnecessary devices from the computer.

2 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.

Exit any open applications and close all open windows.

3 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the following files.

- Uninstall Steinberg AXR Applications.app
- Uninstall Advanced FX Suite.app
- Uninstall Yamaha Steinberg Thunderbolt Driver.app

4 Click [Run] when the “Welcome to the *** uninstaller” window appears.

*** represents the software name.

After that, follow the on-screen instructions to uninstall the software.

5 After the “Uninstallation completed” window appears, indicating the operation is finished, click [Restart] or [Close].



- When you run the “Uninstall Yamaha Steinberg Thunderbolt Driver.app,” [Restart] is displayed. When you run another software, [Close] is displayed.
- When you click [Restart], and a message prompting you to restart your computer appears, click [Restart].

Uninstallation of the software is now complete.
