About HALion Symphonic Orchestra

HSO 24-bit on HALion 3

The first version of HALion Symphonic Orchestra was released in 2006 and was based on the HALion 3 engine including a sample library of 27 GB in 24-bit recording resolution.

HSO VST Sound Instrument Set

With the release of HALion Sonic in 2010 and HALion 4 in 2011 the library was restructured to the new HALion engine and became a VST Sound Instrument Set for HALion and HALion Sonic. The preset programming was reworked, the sample resolution was limited to 16-bit and new features like Note Expression and key switches were integrated into the sound programming.

The new library could only be loaded in HALion, HALion Sonic and HALion Sonic SE. Owners of the 24-bit HALion 3 version of HALion Symphonic Orchestra could use the VST Sound Instrument Set with their existing license.

HSO independent plug-in

In 2014 the HALion Symphonic Orchestra VST Sound Instrument Set was re-released as a download product and equipped with the monotimbral HALion Engine Player to make it available as an independent instrument plug-in in VST 3, VST 2 and AU hosts. The library can still be loaded into the multitimbral workstations HALion, HALion Sonic and HALion Sonic SE. Owners of the 24-bit HALion 3 version of HALion Symphonic Orchestra can download the full installer of the new version on the support pages and use the VST Sound Instrument Set with their existing license.



HALion Symphonic Orchestra 1.1.1

This version fixes a bug that only occurred on the Mac and therefore is only available for the Mac installer.
